Race Notes:

The races are held under USA Cycling permit and officiated by USCF officers and referees.

Helmets required for all racers.

Racers (parents and guardians) are responsible for bringing a bike in safe, working condition.

Field limit for all races, except pursuit, is 35 racers.

Boys and girls will race together, but will be scored separately.

Separate boys and girls-only races will be held in case of large fields, upon referees' decision.

Competing in more than one race will be allowed, i.e., one race and the pursuit or other combinations. Each racer will be entitled to **one** raffle entry independently from how many races he/she will compete in.

Course: Events will be held on the grassy turf inside the running track and on the track at Manchester Field, behind the Winchester McCall Middle School, as per schedule. The racecourses are flat.

Support: Members of the NorthEast Bicycle Club will be present on the field to manage the events and encourage, mentor and assist all racers.

Mechanical assistance will be provided on the field by the Cycle Loft.

Registration: Starting at 10:30am on Manchester Field.

Entry: FREE!! Includes USCF one day license **and insurance. Plus, one of the registered and competing racers could win a raffled junior bike offered by the CycleLoft!!**

A donation of \$5 per racer would be greatly appreciated.

Parent or guardian MUST be present to sign entry forms. Make sure that names, address and telephone numbers are correct. If you are the winner of the bike, but we cannot identify you it will be given to somebody else!

Left on Church St. to traffic light at Bacon St.

Right on Bacon St.

Take 7th left onto Mystic Valley Parkway.

Manchester Field is about 1/4 mile on the right hand side.

Please park along Mystic Valley Parkway not in the school parking lot
